Volunteer Experience:

In the late 70's, I was active in the League of Women Voters of Ohio and occupied seats on several planning commissions in Springfield, Ohio and Columbus, Ohio. Through the League, I gained valuable skills in government participation by monitoring the courts, city and county government meetings and hearings, preparing testimony for these entities on behalf of the League. I ultimately joined a coalition that was responsible for drafting legislation in the State of Ohio for mandatory restitution for non-violent crimes committed in the State. That legislation became law as a direct result of our lobbying efforts. I was a registered lobbyist with the State of Ohio during that time. I enjoyed my commitments to the community through my efforts in the League and, as a result, have remained participatory in local community government as much as possible while working at my various professions.

During my working years, I've had varied careers that have provided a wide scope of experience and perspectives. I've worked retail, was a cabinetmaker for about 10 years and have managed many properties with my late husband in my later years. Among those properties was the Ocean Cove Inn here in Yachats. It was there that I grew to love and appreciate the diversity and cohesiveness that is Yachats. It's energy and spirit have welcomed me and have led me to choose it as my permanent home for my retirement years.
